

Minutes for Lake & Valley Trap League Meeting of June 28, 2009, 2:53 P.M. at Albion

1. Call to Order by Pres. Peters at 2:53 P.M.
2. Roll Call of Member Club had Albion, Greenville, Linesville and Saegertown represented.
3. Recognition of Guests and Visitors: Dorian and Kathy Monroe and Judy Stangel attended as visitors.
4. Reading of Minutes: Written copy provided to all attending M&PS to waive reading. UC
5. Financial Report was given by Treasurer Nancy Peters. The ending balance is currently \$213.56 but there is still one outstanding bill to First Choice pending. UC
6. Secretary's Report (Review of 2008-2009 Season) and a packet of team season records was provided in written form to all attending prior to the meeting. A brief summary was given by Sec. Pyrdek. UC

8. New Business
 - A. Applications received for Membership of new clubs (None received).
 - B. Rule(s) change(s) proposed for adoption:
 - I. Following discussion regarding participation and attendance in the League shoots and the impact of the decline in League activity, it was moved to return to the ten shoot season as in years prior to the just completed season. UC
 - II. A motion to eliminate the Rookie category because of a lack of participation over the past several years was made. MPS UC
 - C. Proposed Fees for coming target year Following discussion, M&PS to continue the fees at the present structure at \$7.00 per shoot (\$6.00 to host club-\$1.00 to League) with Junior shooters fee being \$3.00 to the club and no league dues. It was noted that, by Executive Board action, the fee could be increased by \$0.50 should increased costs warrant such action. The Executive Board (President, Vice-Pres., Treasurer and Secretary) will determine if and when the increased fee will be instituted. UC.
 - D. Proposed schedule Adoption: Much discussion took place regarding the attendance and League scheduling, especially as regards the declining attendance and subsequent financial impact on the League. Two different proposed schedules, one an eight shoot season, the other a ten shoot season was presented by Secretary Pyrdek. The eight shoot schedule was NOT adopted. The 10 shoot Four Team scheduled originally proposed by Sec. Pyrdek was amended to allow Linesville to conduct their Ducks Unlimited shoot on the originally proposed scheduled date and then final scheduled was then M&PS for adoption. UC The amended schedule is included as part of the minutes of record for this meeting. **There will be ten shoots scheduled with January and February having a scheduled shoot.**

10. Nomination and Election of Officers for 2005-2006 Season

Secretary Pyrdek rose and took the Chair for the purpose of conducting the election process for the office of President. Ron Peters was the only nominee. Mr. Peters accepted the nomination and was declared President by acclamation. Mr. Peters then took over the meeting to conduct the remaining election process. William Stangel was the sole nominee for Vice-President. He accepted the nomination. Nancy Peters

was the sole nominee for Treasurer. She accepted the nomination. Joe Pyrdek was the sole nominee for Secretary. He accepted the nomination.
